Tony Hall: With no resources, Tony took charge to become *Director of Ground Zero Food Volunteers*, feeding workers and volunteers for days, weeks and months after the attack. He put his experience to work again in the wake of Hurricane Katrina and founded *STARS* – Small Town American Response – so that he can continue to help others.

Mary Beth Tyrens: With family and friends, Mary Beth collected food and supplies for the workers at Ground Zero. Known as the “Cheesesteak Family”, she and her three young children drove from Philadelphia to New York City every weekend through December 2001 to provide sandwiches and other items to the Food Volunteers.
